

PROS OF SCHEDULES

What is a schedule?

Details pertaining to doors, windows, finish notes, cabinets and appliances are usually categorized into a schedule, or table, thus eliminating the need for numerous leaders and notes all over the drawing. By scheduling information into a central location it not only becomes easier to find, but makes the drawing look cleaner and more appealing to all parties involved.

Door Schedules

Door schedules show information pertaining to every door within a building. The following information is typical of a door schedule:

- Door reference number
- Door width, height and thickness
- Manufacturer, type and UL rating
- Door and frame materials
- Finish notes
- Details referencing the jamb, header and threshold assembly
- Additional notes as needed

Window Schedules

Window schedules show information pertaining to every window within a building. The following information is typical of a window schedule:

- Window reference number
- Window width and height
- Manufacturer and type
- Frame materials and finish notes
- Details referencing the jamb, header and sill assembly
- Additional notes as needed

Finish Schedules

Finish schedules enhance the interior elevation drawings by specifying how each room should be finished. The following information is typical of a finish schedule:

- Each room number and name
- Columns for floor, base, each wall and ceiling
- Wall height
- Additional notes as needed
